And, when we are clothed in the proper wedding garment, we are invited to a more intimate relationship in God's Kingdom.

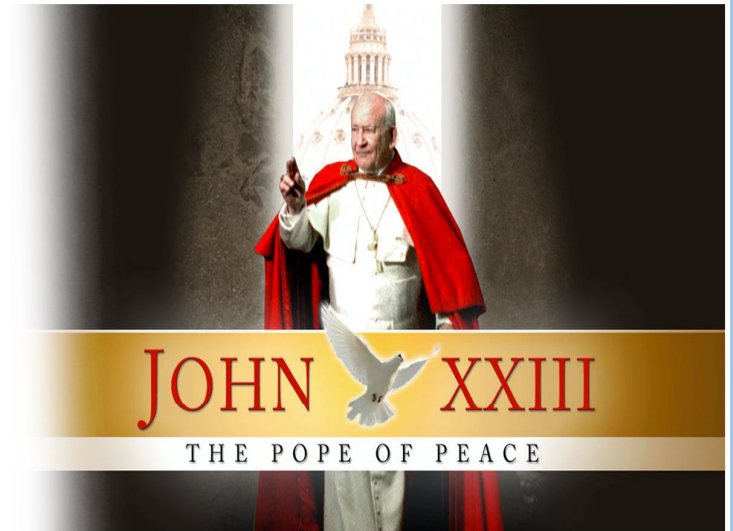
