Healing Restlessness

One of the suggested dismissals at the end of Mass in the Roman Missal is, "Go and announce the Gospel of the Lord." This powerful charge highlights exactly our mission and purpose in life – to bear witness to Christ, to His message, and the power of His goodness. As Jesus ascended, He didn't say, "Go have a good time; go 'find yourselves.'" No. Jesus blessed His disciples and said, "Go be my witnesses to all the nations." The disciple's mission and purpose become our mission and purpose. Some of us are God's witnesses as priests, deacons, or consecrated religious. Others are called to be mothers, fathers, humble workers, and/or great leaders to witness about Christ Jesus. Regardless of who we are, each of us is called to bear witness by the sincerity, faithfulness, and loving kindness in which we live our everyday lives. If we are not in union with this mission or purpose as the most important thing we do each day, then it is easy to become restless. And when restlessness sets in, nothing seems to satisfy. It is paramount to never lose sight of your mission. In Luke's gospel, right before Jesus ascended, he "raised his hands and blessed them." Then He ascended, and His disciples "returned to Jerusalem with great joy" (Lk 24:46-53). Why were they joyful? Because in blessing the disciples and giving them a purpose, Jesus gave them a sense of meaning and purpose. Today, let us not be restless. Let us find meaning and purpose as we are blessed at the end of Mass; our restlessness will be healed, and we will be empowered to joyfully "Go and announce the Gospel of the Lord."




Debbie Leonard Retires!


