I GOT YOUR BACK

"Your light shall break forth like the dawn, and your wound shall quickly be healed" (Is 58:8)

The Lord exhorts us, through the prophet Isaiah, to build up our relationships. We are called to look at our family, our co-workers and our friends with the attitude of õI got your back.ö Instead of becoming self-centered and numb to other s needs, we must assure that we do not turn on those God has placed in our lives. Isaiah, in chapter 58, exhorts the self-righteous Israelites to spend more time building up their relationships and not tearing one another down. Isaiah pleads õshare your bread,ö õclothe the naked,ö õsatisfy the afflictedö and õdo not turn your back on your own.ö We can õhave one anotherøs backö by sharing our food, our monies and our talents to feed each other physically, mentally and spiritually. We have to clothe those around us that are suffering from a raw pain. We are called in simple ways to comfort, love and care for those afflicted and not turn our backs on anyone. There are a lot of needs out there. Heck, we have our own needs. But, in order for oyour light to break forth like the dawn and your wound (i.e. self-righteousness, fear) quickly healed,ö Isaiah says that one must constantly onot turn their backs on our owno and ocry out to the Lord for help.ö As we come before the Lord in faith, let us look around us and be award of the ways we are called to cry out to the Lord, when called to have one another back, so that we can support one another in being a õlight to the world.ö izusing J. 
