

MERCY - THE SALVE THAT HEALS ALL WOUNDS

The ultimate experience of mercy is when God's love meets our brokenness. This weekend, as we celebrate Divine Mercy Sunday, we rejoice in the mercy of God that becomes the salve, the anointment that heals our deepest wounds. We witness the depth of Jesus' mercy in the Gospel reading, where he appears to the very disciples who had abandoned him just three days previously. Jesus' mercy pierces their fears, regrets, and guilt for betraying him. Jesus' mercy meets their woundedness by saying, "Peace be with you." But Jesus does not stop there. Jesus sends the disciples to share his mercy with the very people who had him crucified (John 20: 19-31). This Divine Mercy weekend is the perfect chance to focus on the floodgate of mercy God pours forth upon anyone who calls on his name. God's mercy cares for the wounds resulting from the death of a spouse. God's mercy strengthens those who are downhearted. God's mercy forgives those who are tied down because of sin. God's mercy is the very "sav" that heals the deepest of wounds. The "ABC of Mercy" is very simple: "A," ask for his mercy; "B," be merciful; "C," completely trust in the Lord's mercy. Not only do we celebrate how God heals our wounds, but we are called to bring others to God's mercy. We need to ensure that we are teaching our children of God's mercy. We need to make sure that we are lifting up those in prayer who are entangled in their own sins, blind to God's presence in their lives. We must ensure those around us are experiencing God's mercy in and through what we say and do. God's mercy is the very "salve" that heals all wounds. Let us place ourselves and others in the midst of the healing font of Fr Jeffrey Waldyr God's Divine Mercy.

Friends, our magnificent Gospel today declares that there is no greater manifestation of the divine mercy than the forgiveness of sins. We are in the upper room with the disciples, those who had denied, betrayed, and abandoned their master. Jesus came and stood in their midst. When they saw him, their fear must have intensified; undoubtedly, he was back for revenge. Instead, he spoke the simple word "Shalom," peace. He showed them his hands and his side, lest they forget what the world

(and they) did to him, but he does not follow up with blame or retribution—only a word of mercy. And then the extraordinary commission: "Receive the Holy Spirit. Whose sins you forgive are forgiven them, and whose sins you retain are retained." Jesus' mercy is communicated to his disciples, who in turn are sent to communicate it to the world. This is the foundation for the sacrament of Penance, which has existed in the Church from that moment to the present day as the privileged vehicle of divine mercy.

Catholic Parish Coordinator Position

Position: The Columbus AFB Chapel is accepting bids for a part-time Catholic Parish Coordinator to be paid by the Chapel Tithes and Offerings Fund (CTOF).

Requirements: The Catholic Parish Coordinator serves as a coordinator, planner, advisor, and resource manager for any and all activities pertinent to the Columbus Chaplain Corps Catholic Faith Community. The Contractor is primarily responsible for planning, organizing, and coordinating the Catholic Parish Coordinator program. The applicant should have two years of experience as a program coordinator, two years of experience in management, and a working knowledge of the Catholic faith. Applicants must be able to secure permission to enter a military installation (no felony convictions/arrests, be drug free, etc.). Contract award is contingent upon receiving favorable results from a criminal history background check for positions involving contact with children below 18 years of age as directed by DoDM 1402.05.
