The Solemnity of the Most
Holy Trinity

Moving from “Faith” to “Joy”

There are many people that just seem to be “stuck”. It might be because of interpersonal issues at home, at work, with their family or it might be something more serious like a personal illness, debility or addiction. When caught up in the spiral of what sometimes feels like survival of the fittest, we say that we have “faith” in God—but do we? This Solemnity of the Most Holy Trinity reminds us of an important fact - if we are going to move forward from “faith” to a life of “joy” we have to allow God to lead and guide us through the hard times/sufferings/afflictions. St. Paul reminds us that in being “justified” by “faith” that God’s love, through the Father, Son and Holy Spirit, is “poured out into our hearts” to help us with our “afflictions”. These graces turn our afflictions into endurance, and endurance into character, and character into hope. (Rm 5: 5). Yes, to allow God as Father, Son and Holy Spirit to help move us from “faith” to true “joy”, means we have to constantly surrender ourselves to God our Father, look for Jesus to lead and be driven by the Holy Spirit. Like being good at anything, this takes a lot of practice. Heck some people can’t even get to the point of being led by Jesus and driven by the Holy Spirit, because they don’t want to surrender to God the Father. We are called to stop wasting our time spinning our wheels in the midst of difficulties/suffering/pain and decide where are we stuck. Are you stuck surrendering to God our Father, being led by Jesus or being driven by the Holy Spirit? All three are essential. All three are important. Work at getting unstuck and your path will move from affliction to endurance, endurance to character and character into hope. This is the path that guarantees a movement from “faith” to true “joy”.

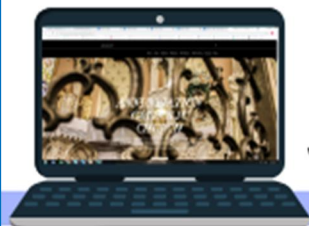

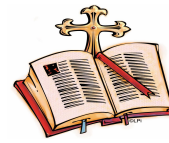
