DOES YOUR WORK GLORIFY GOD?

St. Paul in his second letter to the Thessalonians is trying to strike a balance in the new Christians lives. They irrationally believed that they did not have to work anymore, because the world was about to end, and they were good with the Lord. St. Paul is pleading that everyone has to work and when working to keep the Lord always in mind (2 Thes. 3: 7-12). For us today, the second part is essential - keeping the Lord in mind while we work. It is easy to experience grace when we pray, when we are at Church, and when we are celebrating one of the sacraments. But, focusing on the abundant grace of God when we are cleaning the house, when we are doing homework or when we are at the job becomes a challenge. The reality is that God desires each of us to transform the little, but essential, part of our world into something amazing. Each of us has a unique mission from God. When we refuse in our work to glorify God then part of the goodness God intended for the world goes undone. It is a fact that great things happen when we say öyesö to God—and a öyesö to God is a öyesö to transforming the part of this world entrusted to you. Even if you don't like what you have to do at times, what has become too mundane or what may not be going your way, God's concern is that you are transforming the world around you. Are you being diligent? Are you being honest? Are you keeping the Lord before you at all times as you work? Let us be ever astute on how each of us are called to glorify God in the little part of this world that has been entrusted to each of us.

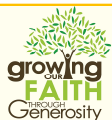
