

## Be as Generous as Generosity is to You

What do you do with the generosity of others that comes your way? In the gospel reading, Jesus reminds us that "storing up the harvest," building bigger barns when we have a better-thanexpected harvest, is not ideal (Lk 12:13 21). In the parable, the man's first instinct with his plentiful harvest was to build bigger barns so that he could sit back and "eat, drink, and be merry." Jesus' challenge is not what we save or don't save. The challenge is what place does success/generosity have in our lives? When you make a good salary? When you get a bonus? When someone is extra kind to you? When the stock market is up? When extra money comes in that you didn't expect? When you are on the receiving end of someone else's generosity, what do you do? Do you greedily keep the "more" for yourself, or are you as generous as generosity is to you? As they say, to those who are given more, more is expected. Yes, financially saving and being fiscally wise is good, prudent, and just. But, while caring for you and even your family's needs, what do you do on those days that you have "extra"? Do you put more in the bank? Buy better things? Do you bask in your own ego? In Psalm 90 we hear, "Teach us to number our days aright, that we may gain wisdom of heart....[so] If today you hear his voice, harden not your hearts." I think that we are called to assure that greed does not control and harden our hearts by making sure we are listening to how the Lord is calling us to be as generous as generosity is to us.






