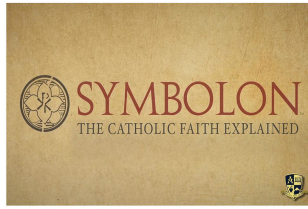

SYMBOLON: EP. 1 - THE JOURNEY: TRINITY, FAITH AND THE GOD WHO IS LOVE

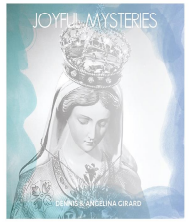

THE JOYFUL MYSTERIES WITH DENNIS AND ANGELINA GIRARD

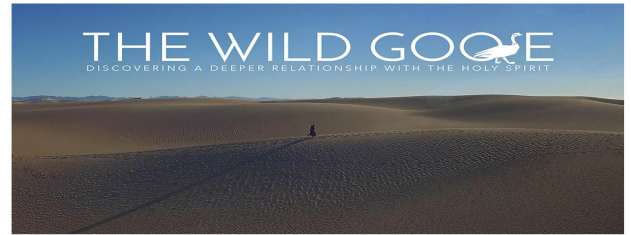
