## Do Not Remain Unrepentant, but Repent

It is easy to become numb to sin in general, much less the more deadly/mortal sins. Saying the Lord's name in vain has become habit. Living together before marriage is considered acceptable. Sunday Mass or Spiritual Communion is treated as an option. Cheating at home, at work, at school or in a relationship is supposed to be overlooked. Jesus in the Parable of the Wheat and the Weeds (Mt 13: 24-43) reminds us that there is a difference between wheat and weeds. There is a real difference between those who repent of their sins (wheat) and those who do not (weeds). Jesus explains that the weeds stand for the unrepentant sinners, people whose priority is themselves. They use others for their own advancement or pleasure. For those people, Jesus is clear ó they find themselves in òthe fiery furnace, where there will be wailing and grinding of teeth.ö The wheat stands for the righteous, those who resisted the seductions of evil, repented from their sins, and battled against selfishness in order to follow Jesus Christ. For those of us choosing to stand up for righteousness, Jesus is clear ó we will enter the joy of eternal life, shining òlike the sun in the kingdom of their Father.ö Let us not become numb to sin. Let us not remain unrepentant, but repent. Take time daily to ask God for forgiveness=forgive others=forgive yourself. More importantly, remember to take time for the Sacrament of Reconciliation for those more deadly/mortal sins. The reality is that forgiving and being forgiven is one of the most freeing, life-giving, joy-filled ways to live your life. Do not remain unrepentant but repent.

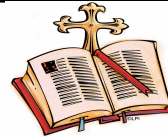
