One of the suggested dismissals at the end of Mass in the new Roman Missal is, õGo and announce the Gospel of the Lord.ö This powerful charge highlights exactly our mission/purpose in life ó to bear witness to Christ, to His message and the power of His goodness. As Jesus ascended, He didnot say, õGo have a good time=go find yourselvesøö No. Jesus blessed them and said, õGo be my witnesses to all the nations.ö The disciples mission/purpose becomes our mission/purpose. Some of us are Godøs witnesses as priests, deacons or as consecrated religious. Others are called to be mothers, fathers, humble workers and/or great leaders to witness about Christ Jesus. Regardless of who we are, each of us is called to bear witness by the sincerity, faithfulness, and loving kindness in which we live our everyday lives. If we are not in union with this mission/purpose, as the most important thing we do each day, then it is easy to become restless. And when restlessness sets in, nothing seems to satisfy. It is paramount to never lose sight of your mission. In Lukeøs gospel, right before Jesus ascended, he õraised his hands, and blessed them.ö Then He ascended and His disciples õreturned to Jerusalem with great joyö (Lk 24:46-53). Why were they joyful? 




