“Selfless Sacrifices”

In the Gospel reading, Jesus gives us a perfect example of what it means to “selflessly sacrifice” for one another in the person of the good Samaritan (Lk 10: 25-37). The Samaritan (a Jew) put himself out there by saving a half-dead traveler (Palesⁿian). The Samaritan did not know the Palesⁿian. Ma^tter of fact, Jews and Palesⁿians considered each other mortal enemies. No ma^tter their differences, the Samaritan selflessly took a huge risk, was not concerned about costs, and was not worried about what he was going to get out of the situa^tion. It was about “selflessly sacrificing” for someone in need. In today’s self-absorbed world, it becomes countercultural and challenging to “selflessly sacrifice” for another. Yet the reality is that it happens all of the ^time: single people, widows and widowers that are generous with their gi^fts and talents; wives/husbands that are constantly there for one another; parents suppor^ting their children in difficult situa^tions; siblings caring, rather than bickering, with one another; families that are at Church each weekend; hospital and hospice support staff that are there in our most vulnerable moments; department store workers that will walk the length of the store for you; people that do you wrong that are genuinely sorry; those that love to rescue animals in need. Good Samaritans, men/women, girls/boys, who “selflessly sacrifice” for others are far more following God’s call/mission than any self-absorbed person or en^tity. One lady stated on her Instagram page this past week, “A happy marriage is a selfless journey in which the happiness of another person is essen^tial to your own.” As we walk through this day that the Lord has made, let us rejoice at the many opportuni^ties placed before us to “selflessly sacrifice” for each other, regardless of risk, cost, or gain.

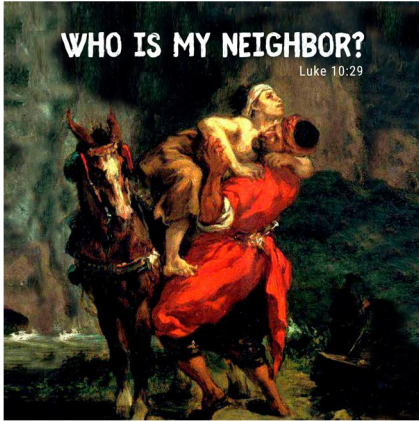
