PRAYERFUL GRATITUDE

It can feel miserable when we are sick or having a bad day where nothing seems to be going well. After a couple of days of God's healing grace, the worst days become the best days. On those "best of days", how do you respond? How do you respond to God's grace-filled healing in your life? In the scriptures, we find several instances when Jesus was faced with a full day ministering to people. The energy and excitement of being healed of body, mind and/or soul was infectious. In each of these instances, what did Jesus do? The scriptures say Jesus got up the next day "before dawn" and "went off to a deserted place, where he prayed" (Mark 1: 37). As so many were experiencing the "best of days," Jesus went "off to a deserted place" in prayerful gratitude for all of God's mercy and healing. When we have experienced the Lord's healing in our lives, it is easy in those "best of days" to go right back to our daily lives and routines, forgetting what we just went through, forgetting God's grace, forgetting that we should stop a bit in prayerful gratitude. Let us remember in those "best of days" when the Lord's grace and mercy are strongest in our lives to find that "out of the way place" and rest awhile. We should never forget to rest in prayerful gratitude.
