Whatever fear, anger or resentment that Joseph felt, it didn't get the best of him. I believe that many 2mes it is frustra2ng when our lives do not go as planned. But, if we are faithful to God's Will, whether His Will comes through a sacrament, through a dream or through others, we have nothing to fear. During these last days of Advent, let us be ever more aware of the direct and indirect ways that God reveals "God's Self" to each of us. 
