Pentecost Sunday

**“The Spirit of God Rests Upon Us,
The Spirit of God Consecrates Us,**

The Spirit of God Bids Us Go Forth to Proclaim His Peace, His Joy

These are the words to an old hymn that I sang with joy as a child. This simple refrain captures the heart of what Pentecost Sunday, the birth of the Church, is all about. First, the Spirit of God rests upon us. One of the first aspects of the Holy Spirit is that the Spirit continually rests upon us, dwells with us, protects us and cares for us. This is important, because while there are many people and things that pull us away from God, the Holy Spirit works hard to care for us, protect us and encourage us to continue on. After resting upon us, if we are open, the Spirit of God consecrates us. This is what we truly celebrate in the Acts of the Apostles. The Holy Spirit descended on the disciples who were plagued with shyness, sadness, insecurity and confusion. So too does the Holy Spirit descend on us consecrating us in order that our imperfections or bad habits do not overtake us. After descending upon us and consecrating us, the Spirit of God bids us to go forth to proclaim His peace, His joy. If we are truly filled with the Holy Spirit, one cannot help but follow the Spirits prompting to share, to freely give that which we have been generously given. Yes, we celebrate that the Holy Spirit rests upon us, consecrates us and sends us forth. As Easter People we are called not to be locked up in our own inner homes of pain, hurt, resentment or unforgiveness. We are called to open our hearts to the Holy Spirit who rests, consecrates and sends us forth to proclaim His peace, His joy.

NOT SEEING EYE-TO-EYE WITH JESUS JUNE 14-16

"I came into the world for judgment, so that those who do not see might see, and those who do see, might become blind...Because you claim you can see, your sin remains." John 9:39

As we look closely at the gospel stories of Jesus' encounter with people, over and over what is exposed is the contrast between what we see and what Jesus sees-- they are never the same.

The question is: Do I want to see what Jesus sees? Can I think of examples in my life where Jesus' way of seeing changed the way I see?

Do I think Jesus sees me the way I see myself? If not, is the difference important to me? Do I want to see myself as Jesus sees me? Conversion happens only when this change in Seeing occurs.

Presenter: Fr. Henry Shelton, a priest of the Jackson diocese. Since his retirement, he has conducted many seminars and retreats in MS and the surrounding states.
